

Coveralls

Engineering Traditions

Materials:

- 1 Pair Dark Blue Coveralls. Available at Mark's Work Warehouse
- 3 White Stripes: either
 - White ribbon:
 - length > shoulder height, for width = 2''
 - length > 2 * shoulder height, for width = 1''
 - White Fabric Paint and masking tape
- 1 Large Moose Logo Patch + 1 Regular Moose Logo Patch
- Patches from other universities engineering clubs
- Offensive things to sew/iron on and beverages

Axioms: The middle stripe is 2'', the outer stripes are 1'', the gap is 1/2'', all gaps between letters and other things is 1/2'', the second S sits on the bottom of the pocket.

Prerequisites: Must be engaged in BEvERaging throughout.

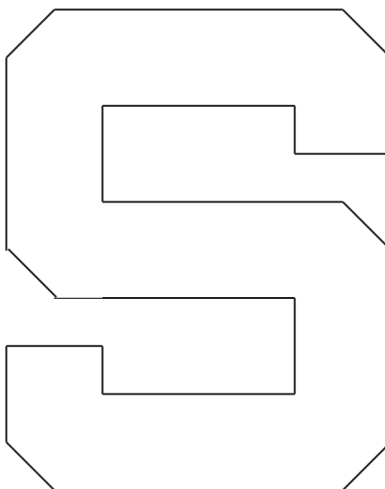
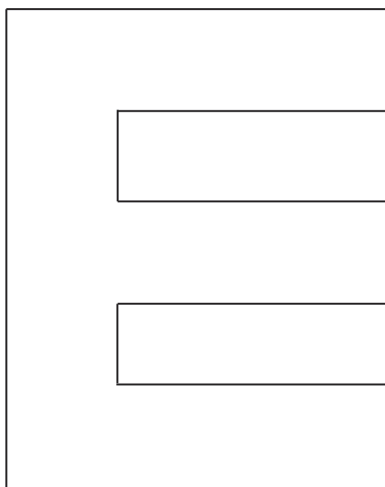
Procedure:

1. Pin the stripes on and sew them. The chest pocket will be sewn shut but the waist pocket doesn't have to be.

OR

1. Place masking tape in the gaps and boundaries and paint on some stripes and letters.
2. Sew/Iron on all the patches you have acquired.
